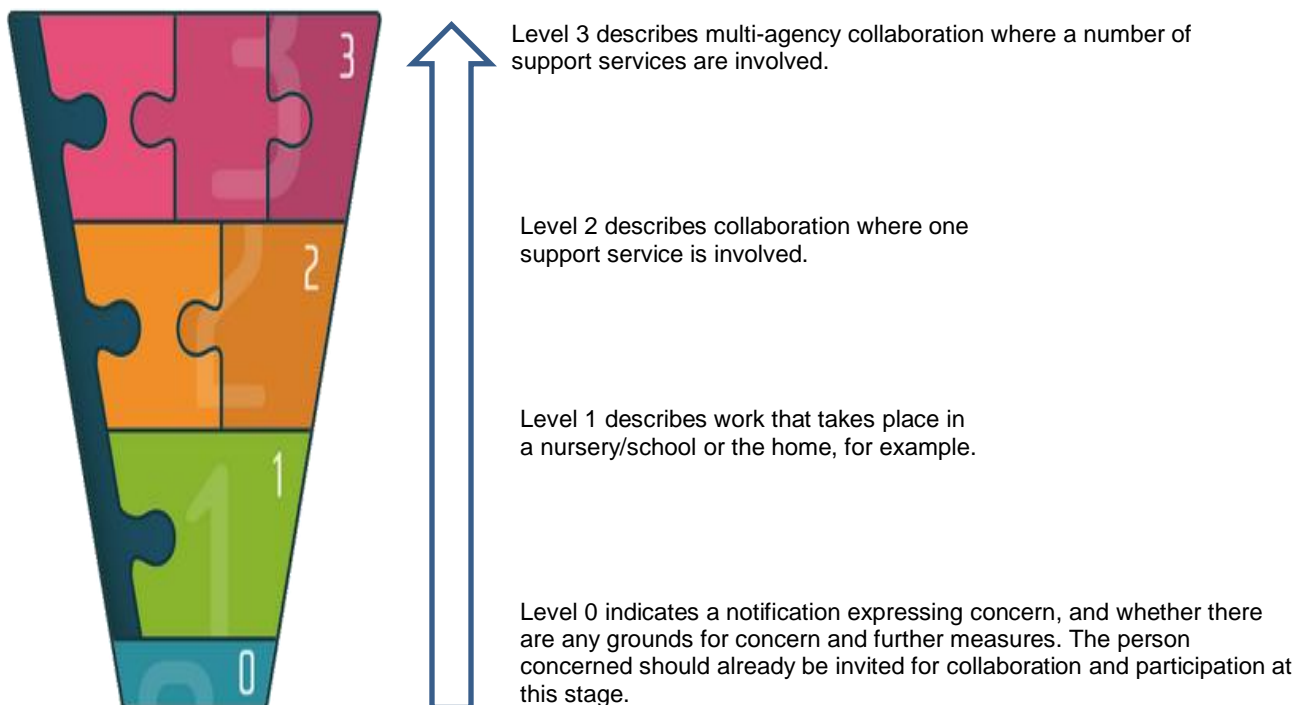
BTI – Better Multi-agency Collaboration (*Bedre Tverrfaglig Innsats*) for children and young people

In Kongsberg, a number of specialist groups work together to provide pregnant women, children, young people and their guardians with high-quality services.

We offer holistic, integrated services with no gaps in support – the right initiative, at the right time together with the person concerned.

The model is intended to ensure a systematic approach to the work, and describes what is to be done.

The model comprises four levels, where 0 is the first level:



The jigsaw pieces in the figure symbolise the fact that the range of services provided are composite in nature and indicate the number of services involved at the time in question. The dark jigsaw piece extends between the other pieces and binds the various levels together. This symbolises the relay batten holder (the coordinator) and the BTI log (overview of measures) that quality-assure the work being performed. The dark vertical jigsaw piece also ensures that the initiative is documented and that responsibility is allocated between the various services and the home.
